

## **Victorian Ash/Tasmanian Oak Model Billiard Table.**

Frame and cushion rails and legs are made out of Victorian Ash/Tasmanian Oak Timber.

Tasmanian Oak is a hardwood timber grown in Tasmania.

Tasmanian oak is light in colour, varying from straw to reddish brown with intermediate shades of cream to pink. It is recognised for its excellent staining qualities, which allow ready matching with other timbers, finishes or furnishings.

Tasmanian oak is also marketed under different names depending on where it is being grown and sold.

In Victoria and NSW it is also sold under the trade name Victorian ash.

Victorian Ash is a hardwood grown in Victoria.

Victorian ash timber can range from a pale pink to pale yellow or brownish colour.

All the frame work is approximately 38mm thick and all table joints are rebated. The depth of the frame is approximately 245mm. The frame also comes with blocks, mouldings, draw, panels and plain scrolls.

Legs are 7" thick turned timber legs. (Tas oak / Vic Ash) Comes standard with Barrassi design leg, but you also have the option of going with a fluted or square. It also comes with large brass feet.

The cushions rails have 4 pieces to it and it has been biscuit laminated. The top width of the rail is approximately 70mm. It has sliding panels which covers the cushion bolts.

The rubber that is used is a gum moulded rubber. The rubber sits on a rebated timber blocked to give it extra support and to stop from pulling away from the block. The rubber block is then screwed with 5 screws to the cushion rail.

It has Brazilian slate base ¾" thick and it's screwed to the frame.

The cloth that is used is English Strachan 6811B.

The table has large brass brackets. The R3 design or R16. It also has heavy leathers and white nets.

The table is finished in its natural tone with a semi gloss finish.
